# **Academics**



## Reading

We finished our first unit of reading!!
This week we learned a few different ways authors give us clues for tricky words. We discussed being a monster truck and figuring out the meaning of the word, instead of skipping it (don't drive around the word, roll over it like a monster truck and figure out the meaning). We briefly discussed how figurative language is used in books. We ended our week by discussing questions you should be thinking about as you read your book.

#### Math

We practiced our subtraction skills the first day this week, then we reviewed for our unit 1 test. The day before the test I showed students their pre-assessment. Many students were surprised by how many questions they didn't understand and now they do. They were excited to show me what they learned! They spent two days taking the test. Once it is scored and I have reviewed it with the students, I will let you know when the

#### **Writing**

We finished looking at the checklist for grade 3 and for grade 4 to continue to help students see ways to push themselves when writing. Many students told me they found the checklist very helpful! We are still working on telling a true story (also called personal narratives).

### Social Studies

We learned about the continents and the oceans. Did you know there are now 5 oceans? Ask your child to explain.

We finished our read aloud Stone Fox. What a surprise ending! Some students were very, very sad.
