Academics



Reading

We took our reading pre-assessment this week, as well as our STAR reading test. We learned about how we can build a reading life. As well as, reading books like they are gold, instead of like a curmudgeon. We also read a Scholastic News magazine about fidget spinners.

<u>Math</u>

We learned about the number rack this week and practiced making addition equations using the number rack. We looked over our pre-assessment and completed a self-reflection about the assessment.
